Anyone who knew Scott Martinez knew he was a wonderful father, devoted husband and son, and a loyal friend to anyone that touched his life. As Scott did for every home game for the Saints, he set out on October 7, 2007 to meet his friends to cook and cheer on the Saints. However he never made it to the game that day. Scott collapsed at 6:00 am and was taken to Ochsner Hospital. For the next 5 days as he laid in ICU, his family and friends prayed and thought of every best case scenario for Scott. Unfortunately for his family and friends, God had other plans for Scott. On October 12, 2007, Scott passed away. Scott is survived by his wife Katy and young daughter Riley Beverly.

Although health and life insurance will cover some of the costs, financially this will take a toll on the family. The Friends In Need Foundation, Inc. is organizing a benefit for The Martinez Family which will be held on Sunday, June 1, 2008. The benefit will be held at Rock N Bowl in New Orleans from 2:30 pm to 6:30 pm. A donation of \$100 admits two to a reception and silent auction with live entertainment donated by The Chee Weez. The proceeds from this event will defray a small portion of medical expenses incurred during this tragedy as well as help ease the burden of the everyday financial expenses to the family.


